EKSONS CORPORATION BERHAD

- *Eksons' results improves year on year*
- *Eksons posted first half year earnings per share of 14.4 sen*
- *Eksons declare interim dividend of 2.5 sen per share*

Kuala Lumpur, 21 November 2007 – Eksons Corporation Bhd (“Eksons”) today announced an improved year on year set of results for the first half of its financial year 2008 and declared a maiden tax exempt interim dividend of 2.5 sen per share.

For the first half of its current financial year, Eksons posted a 36.2% increase in profit before taxation to RM27.4 million as compared to RM20.1 million recorded in the corresponding period of the previous financial year. Turnover was RM170.7 million as compared to RM172.1 million in the corresponding period of the previous financial year.

Eksons attributed the improved results to higher profit margins from better plywood selling prices on and savings in energy costs since commissioning its biomass plant earlier this year.

In its announcement to Bursa Malaysia, the Company stated that demand for its plywood for the next few months is expected to remain good as the deterioration in housing starts in the USA is not expected to have an adverse impact on the Company. In fact, the Company’s regular buyers from the USA have started putting in orders again a few months back.

On the effects of the strengthening Ringgit against the US Dollar and the escalating cost of oil on the Company, a spokesman for the Company said “Eksons has taken steps to preserve margins by investing in equipment to improve production efficiencies while strictly controlling raw materials and consumable costs.” He also

expects plywood prices to stabilise following announcement of plans by some Malaysian plywood manufacturers to cut down on production.

The Company's interim dividend will be paid on 27 December 2007 to shareholders registered in the register of members of the Company on 11 December 2007.

About Eksons Corporation Bhd

EKSONS is one of Malaysia's largest manufacturer of thin plywood of <3mm thickness. Production is carried out via two plants in Sibu, Sarawak, and Tawau, Sabah with a combined capacity of approximately 285,000 cubic metres per annum. Over 90% of its products are exported, mainly to the USA, Middle East, Taiwan and Africa.
